## **Auburn University Transport Service**

Auburn University provides an on-campus free shuttle service for students. Under this facility, AU provides the following services:

## **Tiger Transit**

During the fall and spring semesters, Fine Arts, South Quad East Campus and East Glenn will conclude its services at 6 p.m. and the rest of the Tiger Transit is in operation from 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. During the summer semester this operation will be from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Here are <u>multiple routes</u> covering many on-campus and off-campus locations (example: Village Mall, Wal-Mart, Connection, Reserve and few more). For transportation across campus after our regular operational day has ended, the <u>Night</u> <u>Security Shuttle Service</u> is available for on-campus travel.

Please take an advantage of the <u>twenty-two routes</u> that are offered throughout the year. Furthermore, DoubleMap offers a free <u>Rider App</u>, which is available for Android and Apple gadgets and offers real-time location of bus data. For more information visit <u>Tiger Transit</u>

## Friday Shopping Shuttle

The Friday Evening Shopping Shuttle, this shuttle runs each Friday and leaves from the Haley Center Hub/ AU Student Center, starting at 5:30 pm and last at 9:30 pm. All stops are designed as "by request". Upon entering the bus from the Haley Center Hub/ AU Student Center, passengers must inform the driver about the specified shopping place. The most common places for grocery shopping are Walmart, Kroger and Asian Supermarket. To help international students with their weekly grocery shopping, Auburn University provides shuttle service to all of these places. Tiger Town which has a variety of restaurants, utility shops, salons and stores. The Shopping Shuttle also travels to Auburn Mall which has a good deal of shopping options ranging from mobile SIM cards to food and fashion accessories. ## Night Security Shuttle Service

The Night Security Shuttle is a facility that runs from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. and carries passengers to **on-campus locations only**. The operation hours will change during home football games. Any staff or student can call on (334) 844-7400 and talk with the dispatcher to ask for a pickup. The vans are marked with a number (ex. 182). These Night Security Shuttle signs are found on both sides above the rear tire. A flashing light indicates that the shuttle is up for service.
